

## South Carolina Flute Society Master Class Competition

The annual South Carolina Flute Society Master Class Competition is open for all flutists age 30 and under residing in any US state. Winners will be selected on the basis of their recorded qualifying round to perform for Guest Artist Christina Smith at the 2012 South Carolina Flute Society (SCFS) Spring Flute Festival on March 31, 2012 at the Charleston County School of the Arts in Charleston, SC. A staff accompanist will be provided at the contestant's expense, although contestants may bring their own accompanist if desired. The entry fee is \$15.

Submission Qualifications: Applicant must be a current member of the SCFS. Applicants may reside in any US state, and must age 30 or under as of March 31, 2012.

### Materials Required for Submission:

1. SCFS Competition Application Form and \$15 entry fee
2. SCFS Membership Application and membership fee, if not currently a member
3. Three copies of preliminary round CD
4. Biography of applicant (200 characters maximum)

Recordings: Please submit 3 copies of **unedited** preliminary round recorded material on CDs only. Piano accompaniment is not required for the recording. Repertoire should be listed on the CDs; however, *please do not include your name on the CDs.*

### Recorded audition repertoire (in this order):

#### Select to play either:

1. Solo piece of the contestant's choice (winners will perform their piece of choice at the Spring Festival)

OR:

2. Orchestral excerpts in the following order:
  - a.) Debussy *Prélude à l'après-midi d'un faune* Beginning to 3
  - b.) Mendelssohn "Scherzo" from *A Midsummer Night's Dream* Pick-up to 1 m. before P-end
  - c.) Beethoven *Leonore Overture 3#* Beginning- m. 24; 29 m. after E- 61 m. after E

**Submission deadline:** All materials must be received by February 24, 2012.
