Masterclass Performers Competition

Winners will perform in Mark Sparks' masterclass during the festival. The competition is open to any flutist who is an undergraduate or graduate full-time student enrolled in an accredited college, university, or conservatory during the 2016-17 academic year.

Application Process

- Complete SCFS competitions application form, located at scflute.org
- Pay entry fee of \$25
- Provide biography (300-character limit, including spaces) of applicant
- Must be current member of SCFS to enter (see membership form at scflute.org)

Masterclass Performers Competition audition repertoire must be submitted on an unmarked CD. The CD must contain **one selection of the standard repertoire** not to exceed 10 minutes. Application repertoire can also be submitted via *private* SoundCloud URL. All works for flute and keyboard must be recorded using both instruments. Performers chosen to play in the masterclass will perform the same selection submitted for the recorded round.

All materials must be postmarked by February 24, 2017. If submitted electronically, submissions must be uploaded by 11:59pm on February 24, 2017.
